Monday	BLACK BIN ONLY Route 1, Ruisseau-Serpent, the left side of Route 309 North (from the bridge to the village), the entire village and Route 309 South.	Tuesday	BLACK BIN ONLY The right side of Route 309 North (from the bridge to the village), the Val-Ombreuse and Poisson-Blanc roads.
Wednesday	GREEN BIN ONLY Route 1, Ruisseau-Serpent, the left side of Route 309 North (from the bridge to the village), the entire village and Route 309 South.	Thursday	GREEN BIN ONLY The right side of Route 309 North (from the bridge to the village), the Val-Ombreuse and Poisson-Blanc roads.

<p>BLACK BIN</p>  <p>Residual material collection</p>	<p>The following items are accepted: Table scraps (non compostable), non recyclable material such as paper tissue and toilet paper, multi-layer paper, transparent film... glass (window), mirror, ceramic, porcelain... containers made of different materials, CDs, ring binders, grocery and shopping bags, toys, water hose, Styrofoam...</p> <p>The following items are not accepted: Recyclable material, HDW, green residue, computer material</p>
<p>GREEN BIN</p>  <p>Recyclable material collection</p>	<p>The following items are accepted : Paper, cardboard boxes, phone books, unbound books, milk and cream cartons (<i>Tetra Pak</i>), juice boxes without the straws... Any bottles and glass containers (of any colour)... Tin cans and their lids, various beverage cans, clean aluminum plates... Any plastic containers and their lids with the following recyclable symbols: #1, #2, #4, #5 and #7.</p> <p>The following items are not accepted: Plastic bags, Styrofoam, toys, HDW, glass (window), green residues, computer material...</p>
<p>GREEN RESIDUE</p>  <p>Branches, leaves and grass collection</p>	<p>The following items are accepted: Weed, branches (cut in 3-foot pieces and tied into 25-kg packages), grass, garden residue, dead flowers...</p> <p>Collection from April to November: dispose of green residue in bags or boxes</p>
<p>BULKY WASTE</p>  <p>Bulky discard collection</p>	<p>The following items are accepted: Cooking range, dishwasher, dryer, old furniture, hot water tank, bath, shower, sink, basin, toilet, television, barbecue (without the propane tank), bicycle, carpet, pool liner (properly fastened), tarps, construction material.</p> <p>The following items are not accepted: HDW, green residue, computer material, recyclable material, halocarbon appliances (air conditioner...).</p> <p>Maximum: 3 cubic metres Maximum for construction material: 1 cubic metre within the 3 cubic metres.</p> <p>Collection: 3 times a year, in the spring, summer and fall.</p>
<p>NATURAL CHRISTMAS TREES</p> 	<p>The following items are accepted: Natural Christmas trees used during the Holiday season. They must be stripped of all decorations and cut into 6-foot sections (where appropriate).</p> <p>Maximum: 3 natural Christmas trees per dwelling.</p> <p>Collection: January only</p>

WARNING

Do not place hot ashes in the bins.
Maximum bin capacity : 100 kg (220 lbs)
Residual material not placed in the black bins will not be collected

IMPORTANT

Place your handles (wheels) facing the road, on the eve of collection
